

## **NORTH BATTLEFORD TRANSITIONAL LIVING INITIATIVE**

What is Transitional Living?

The North Battleford Transitional Living Initiative (NBTLI) is a Program that provides single adults with affordable, stable, safe living accommodations. These are self-contained furnished (refrigerator, stove, single bed, oven, table, chairs, household items, linen, housewares, etc.) units for a single (1) person. NBTLI is a **sober** living complex where drugs and alcohol are not allowed in the units or on the property. The units are also **non-smoking**. While living in one of the Transitional Units you will have access to a full time Housing Coordinator. (This person is not your landlord) The Housing Coordinator is there to support you with goal setting, problem solving and achieving success, as well as helping you locate services that can help you work on improving basic life and interpersonal skills, educational opportunities, and assisting with job preparation and attainment. These supports are available upon your request. The Housing Coordinator's visits will be scheduled or unscheduled. At least one (1) such visit each month is to have Safety items checked (fire detector/bathroom fan, living conditions etc). If there are issues in the evening it will be the Housing Coordinator who will come to the complex to deal with them, with or without the RCMP.

In order to qualify for this program, you must be at least 16 years of age, be homeless/deemed to be homeless or live in a shelter and have a confirmed income source; this can be the MSS programs. You must also be willing to enter into a Transitional Support Plan (i.e. goal development).

**If you are not willing to, or cannot follow the "NB Transitional Living Regulations" as well as having the Housing Coordinator visiting you on a regular basis this will not be a suitable living arrangement for you. This is not a regular apartment building where you can do what you want; it is a supervised transitional living complex where established rules have to be followed.**



## **NORTH BATTLEFORD TRANSITIONAL LIVING INITIATIVE *REGULATIONS***

(As per section 22.1 of the Residential Tenancies Act, 2016, Right of landlord to impose rules.)

To be reviewed and signed before acceptance into the North Battleford Transitional Living Initiative Program

1. **This is a sober living complex. Illegal drugs, marijuana or drug paraphernalia, alcohol/alcohol bottles or weapons are not allowed in the units. There will be immediate eviction if any weapons or drugs are found in units or on the grounds. The RCMP may be called.**

2. **All Guests have to leave by 10:00 pm. No parties anytime. Guests are not allowed to spend the night. Guests are not to be in units without the tenant being present.**

3. **There are scheduled and unscheduled visits from the Housing Coordinator. These visits may be in the evening.**

4. Residents must contribute towards the maintenance and upkeep of the building and grounds. Put out/back garbage and recycle bins, snow removal, yard care etc.
5. Residents must speak respectfully to the Housing Coordinator, members of NB Transitional Living Initiative and other residents. If there is a conflict seek out assistance to resolve the situation.
6. Residents must establish a case plan / goals as part of the program and follow through on action items and commitments.
7. The volume of TVs, music or other noise is to be kept to a minimum. No slamming doors, shouting or causing disturbances.
8. Do not ask other residents or neighbours to borrow or buy anything.
9. Smoking/vaping of any substance is prohibited.
10. Respect the right to privacy and safety of the other residents.
11. Do not litter or take short-cuts through neighbouring properties.
12. Only resident's bicycles can be taken into units. Guest's bikes cannot be taken up and down the stairwells or into the units. The units are not storage lockers.
13. All appliances, furniture, kitchen and bathroom wares and mattress are the property of NB Transitional Living and should be returned in like-condition as you received them. Any damaged appliances, furniture or missing wares are billable back to the resident. The RCMP will be called for any missing appliances, furniture or mattresses.
14. Units are to be kept tidy. Inform the Housing Coordinator if maintenance is required.  
**Units will be inspected for health and safety reasons on a regular basis.**

If these rules are not followed eviction could result.
